Exposure limit according to §90(i)

FCC ID: NTAALLWM1

The device is classified as mobile.

Limit for power density for general population/uncontrolled exposure is f/1500 mW/cm2 for 300 – 1500 MHz frequency range:

 $P = 450/1500 = 0.3 \text{ mW/cm}^2$

The power density P (mW/cm²) = PT / 4π r²

PT is the transmitted power, which is equal to the peak transmitter output power in 4GFSK modulation mode of 33.2 dBm plus maximum antenna gain 1 dBi, the maximum equivalent isotopically radiated power EIRP is:

 P_T = 33.2 dBm + 1 dBi = 34.2 dBm = 2630.26 mW.

According to the manufacturer's declaration the duty cycle factor for 30min averaging time is 0.00011 hence, the equivalent averaged EIRP is:

Pt=2630.26 mW x 0.00011 = 0.289mW

The power density at 20 cm (minimum safe distance, required for mobile devices), calculated as follows:

 $0.289 \text{ mW} / 4\pi (20 \text{ cm})^2 \approx 0.057 \mu\text{W} / \text{cm}^2 < 0.3 \text{ mW/cm}^2$
