## RF exposure information

In accordance with 47CFR 2.1093(c), FP200INT portable transmitter is categorically exempted from routine environmental evaluation for RF exposure prior to equipment authorization or use since it does not fall within the scope of 2.1093 (c).

The transmitter output power is 0.2 dBm (as per FCC part 15 section C), the antenna gain is 0 dBi, the transmitter output power is 11.1 dBm (as per FCC part 90), the antenna gain is 2 dBi, the maximum equivalent isotropically radiated power (e.i.r.p.) is 13.3 dBm = 21.4 mW < 50 mW.

According to section 3 of Supplement C to OET Bulletin 65 this device is exempted from testing for compliance with SAR limits, which are higher than this handheld transmitter would normally be expected to cause.
