Dear Timothy:

This letter is in regard to your letter dated March 21, 2007 in reference to FCC ID: NUC-IPSERIES. There were two points to address in your letter.

Item 1 FYI regarding the two spurious emissions over class B but under class A limits showing the inquiry was made to the FCC. Thank you. I believe they will find this is appropriate per 15.209 (f). Let me know what is determined.

Item 2: This is now corrected in the application (REV B); the IC application now indicates IP200, IP300, IP600, IP200C, IP300C, and IP600C. The 200, 300, or 600 represent the dpi of the printer and the "C" means the optional automatic label cutter is installed in the printer. If no "C", the user must manually cut the label material with a scissors or use the built-in tear bar.
