

7 Exhibit A – FCC Product Labeling and Warning Statement

7.1 Proposed FCC Label Format

As per FCC §15.19: Labeling Requirements Paragraph 3

(3) All other devices shall bear the following statement in a conspicuous location on the device:

FCC ID: NVJSR2000A

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

Specifications: Text is white in color and is left justified. Labels are printed in indelible ink on permanent adhesive backing or silk-screened and shall be affixed at a conspicuous location on the EUT.

As per FCC §15.121(f)

(f) Scanning receivers shall have a label permanently affixed to the product, and this label shall be readily visible to the purchaser at the time of purchase. The label shall read as follows: WARNING: MODIFICATION OF THIS DEVICE TO RECEIVE CELLULAR RADIOTELEPHONE SERVICE SIGNALS IS PROHIBITED UNDER FCC RULES AND FEDERAL LAW.

As per FCC §15.105: Information to the User

(a) For a Class B digital device or peripheral, the instructions furnished the user shall include the following or similar statement, placed in a prominent location in the text of the manual:

Note: This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment generates uses and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference to radio communications. However, there is no guarantee that interference will not occur in a particular installation.

For products shipped to Canada, please add the following to the product: "This Class B digital apparatus complies with Canadian ICES-003."
