Cellular Specialties respectfully submits for the consideration of the Commission the following response to the Commission's request for further information:

- 1) The notes on the original grant have been corrected by the TCB to reflect the operating limitations, specifically the antenna gain permitted and minimum distances of persons from the antenna to meet the MPE categorical exclusion requirements of 2.1091.
- 2) A revised User Manual is submitted, and will replace the User Manual currently provided with the equipment. This revised manual differs only on page 9: the maximum antenna gain for the Outdoor antenna (11 dBd) and the resulting calculated minimum distance of that antenna from all persons (120 cm.) are revised per the calculations in the MPE compliance document submitted with this application.
