Transmitted herewith on behalf of Baron Services, Inc. (Baron) is its application for equipment authorization for the VHDD-550S Radar System, FCC ID. No. NX5VHDD-550S requesting certification of the foregoing weather radar device in the 2700-2900 MHz band for operations under Part 87 of the FCC's rules, Section 87.173 and Subparts D and E.


Under Part 2 of the FCC rules, the band 2700-2900 MHz is identified primarily for Federal government use and for certain non-Federal operations as described in Section 2.106, US Table of Frequency Allocations, Footnote "US-18" as follows:

"US18 In the bands 9–14 kHz, 90–110 kHz, 190–415 kHz, 510–535 kHz, and 2700–2900 MHz, navigation aids in the U.S. and its insular areas are normally operated by the Federal Government. However, authorizations may be made by the FCC for non-Federal operations in these bands subject to the conclusion of appropriate arrangements between the FCC and the Federal agencies concerned and upon special showing of need for service which the Federal Government is not yet prepared to render."

Baron hereby confirms that it would accept grant of certification subject to the conditions of use and licensing described in Section 2.106, US Table of Frequency Allocations, Footnote "US-18."
