

MISC. EXHIBIT: TUNING INFORMATION [2.1033(B5)]

Tuning: (Training)

The user programs the OBMHL3 as outlined in the Users Manual, Exhibit D. A summary is provided here.

1. Pressing the two outer Homelink buttons until the indicator LED begins to flash resets the memory.
2. Holding the hand-held transmitter to be copied near the OBMHL3 and simultaneously activating the hand-held transmitter and one of the user buttons until the indicator LED flashed rapidly trains the unit to duplicate the hand-held transmitter. The information is stored in the non-volatile memory of the OBMHL3.

During usage, when the “trained” button is pressed, the OBMHL3 recalls the stored information.
