RE: Reason for Class II Change Application for Ingenico Elite 790 CDMA, FCC ID: O34-E790CDMA

Dear Sir/ Madam:

The product, Elite 790 CDMA (FCC ID: O34-E790CDMA) has been tested and certified for PCS Communications. Now, Bay Area Compliance Lab has tested Ingenico's Elite 790 CDMA terminal for Cellular Communications (800 MHz). There has been no change to the product. The reason for testing for 800 MHz is stated below:

Ingenico Canada Ltd. understood that the Bell Network (our wireless service provider) worked only at 1900 MHz for data communications. However, after field-testing at 1900 MHz, we found that some parts of the Bell Network operate at 800 MHz. Consequently, it was our misunderstanding that the network only operated at 1900 MHz that has caused us to request the Class II change to include 800 MHz operation.
