Installation

Assure the receiver has been installed well.

Mouse Connector Keyboard Connector

- Load batteries.
- Install Mouse
 - 1. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press and button on the back of mouse
 - 2. If the mouse could not work, please repeat item 1 again
- First Use / RF Connection
 - 1. Turn off the power of your computer.
 - 2. Remove the existing keyboard and mouse connector
 - 3. Plug the RF receiver connectors into corresponding ports of your computer
 - 4. Install AA and AAA batteries into the keyboard and mouse
 - 5. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press the button on the back of keyboard.
 - 6. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press the button on the back of mouse.
