



Wireless Multimedia Keyboard User Guide



Multimedia Keyboard Hotkey Definition

- ▶/ II Play/ Pause: Press to start to play audio/video file in and press to auto detect to pause playing.
- Stop: Press to auto detect to stop playing or to eject the CD.
- Forward: Press to skip forward to the next file and start to play.
- Backward: Press to skip backward to the previous file and start to play.
- Volume Down: Turn down the Volume
- Mute: Mute On/Off
- Volume Up: Turn up the Volume
- E-mail: Link to launch your E-mail application.

WWW Quickly launch your Internet web browser.

Power(ACPI): Press to put the system to sleep and wake up.



Installation

Assure the receiver has been installed well.

Connect the receiver to your PC by plugging in the receiver's green connector into the mouse port of your PC and also plugging in the receiver's purple connector into the keyboard port of your PC.



- Load batteries.
- Install Keyboard
 - 1. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press and button on the back of keyboard
 - 2. If the keyboard could not work, please repeat item 1 again.
- Insert Magic Keyboard Driver CD into CD-ROM or DVD drive.
- Double click "setup.exe"
- The onscreen setup will guide you through the rest of process.
- After the software installation is completed, you will be promoted to restart your computer.
- If you already have a version of Magic Keyboard on your system, the older version must be uninstalled first before installing the new version.

First Use / RF Connection

- 1. Turn off the power of your computer.
- 2. Remove the existing keyboard and mouse connector
- 3. Plug the RF receiver connectors into corresponding ports of your computer
- 4. Install AA and AAA batteries into the keyboard and mouse
- 5. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press the button on the back of keyboard.
- 6. Press the button in front of the receiver, then press the button on the back of mouse.

Configuring Your Programmable Hot Keys

Your Magic keyboard comes with five programmable hot keys that you can assign to applications, files, shortcut or your favorite web site address. Right click Magic Keyboard icon and chose Option to configure your buttons.
