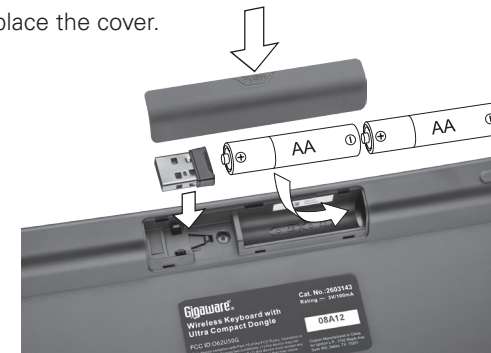

Please read this user's guide before using your new touchpad keyboard.

Install Batteries

1. Open the battery compartment cover at the bottom of the keyboard.
2. Insert two AA batteries according to the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside.
3. Replace the cover.




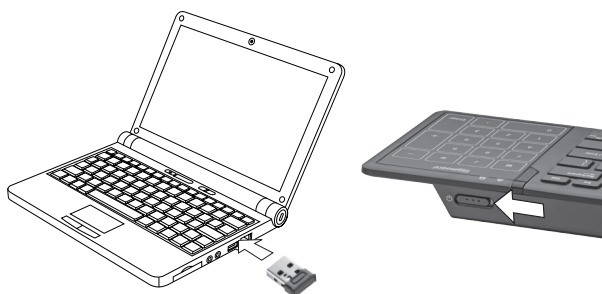
Battery Notes:

- When the keyboard is on and battery is low, the power indicator  flashes. Replace the batteries with new ones.
- Dispose of batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (alkaline or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
- If you do not plan to use the keyboard for some time, remove the batteries. Batteries can leak chemicals that can damage electronic parts.



Plug in the Receiver

1. Remove the USB receiver dongle from the keyboard's battery compartment.
2. Turn on your PC.
3. Plug the receiver into your computer's USB port.
4. Slide the  switch on the back of the keyboard to **ON** (green). Your keyboard and receiver are automatically paired.



Notes:

- If you do not plan to use your keyboard for a long time, slide  switch to **OFF** (red) to save battery power.
- See your operating system's online help for additional keyboard configuration information.

Sleep Mode

Your keyboard enters sleep mode if left idle for 10 minutes or if you unplug the receiver from your USB port. To reactivate your keyboard, press any key (not the touchpad area) or reconnect the receiver (if unplugged).

Fn + F1  


Multimedia Function Keys

- Fn + F2  — Play previous track
- Fn + F3  — Play or pause media
- Fn + F4  — Stop playback
- Fn + F5  — Play next track
- Fn + F6  — Turn mute on and off
- Fn + F7  — Lower speaker volume
- Fn + F8  — Increase speaker volume

Internet Function Keys

- Fn + F9  — Internet
- Fn + F10  — Mail
- Fn + F11  — Search

Scroll Lock (Fn + F12)


Turn Scroll Lock on and off.  icon lights blue when scroll lock is activated

Power Indicator

Flashes when battery power is low.



Caps Lock

Turn caps lock on and off.  icon lights blue when caps lock is activated

Num Lock





Turn the number lock (Num Lock) on and off. The Num Lock LED lights blue when function is activated. Num Lock LED is off when touchpad function is activated.

Touchpad

Press **Num Lock** to turn on the touchpad function. The Num Lock LED turns off.

Scroll		1. Slide two fingers on the touchpad vertically or horizontally in the desired direction. 2. Remove fingers from the touchpad to stop scrolling.	
Drag and drop		Select and move one object: 1. Move cursor to the selected object. 2. Tap once and remove finger from the touchpad. 3. Tap again and hold finger on the touchpad. 4. Move finger to drag the object. Select and move multiple objects: 1. Move cursor to an open space in the window you want to select from. 2. Tap once and remove finger from the touchpad. 3. Tap again and hold finger on the touchpad. 4. Move finger to select a group of objects. 5. Tap to release. 6. Tap and hold finger on the selected objects, then drag the objects to their new location.	

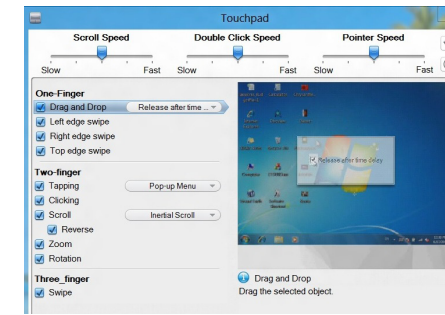

Install the touchpad driver for additional Windows 8 functions.






1. Insert the driver CD into your computer's CD/DVD drive. The CD will run the installation program automatically.
2. Follow the onscreen instructions to complete installation.

A Touchpad shortcut icon  will appear in your taskbar for easy access to touchpad settings and a demonstration.



Note: To access the Touchpad settings and demo go to the **Control Panel**, click **Mouse**, click the **Touchpad** tab, and then click **Options**.

Swipe page	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move three fingers to the left to launch the assigned function (Page Up). • Move three fingers to the right to launch assigned function (Page Down).



Function	Gesture
Toggle to previous app	 <p>Place and hold one finger on the left edge of the touchpad and then swipe to the right.</p>
Toggle Charm Bar	 <p>Place and hold one finger on the right edge of the touchpad and then swipe to the left.</p>
Toggle Application Bar (application dependent)	 <p>Place and hold one finger on the top edge of the touchpad and then swipe down</p>
Supported Applications Only (See “ Supported Applications and Gestures ” on page 11)	
Rotate	 <p>Move two fingers clockwise or counterclockwise.</p>
Zoom in and out	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zoom In: Place two fingers on the touchpad and then move them closer together. • Zoom Out: Place two fingers on the touchpad and move them apart.

Troubleshooting

If you have difficulty pairing your touchpad keyboard with your computer, or if you have difficulty using the gesture controls:

- Make sure you have properly installed fresh batteries.
- Pair the keyboard and receiver again:
 1. Place the keyboard within 2 inches of the receiver dongle.
 2. Press and hold **Right/Ctrl** for 2 seconds then slide the  switch to **ON** (green). Release the **Right/Ctrl** button. The power indicator immediately flashes once when pairing is successful. The power indicator flashes in 5 seconds if pairing fails.
 3. If pairing fails, switch the  switch **OFF** (red), then repeat pairing steps.

Important Information

- Do not place the keyboard or the receiver on a metal surface. Metal may impair the RF communication.
- For optimal performance, place the keyboard closer to the receiver.
- Do not place the receiver on the top of computer, wireless router, or monitor to avoid interference.
- If nearby RF devices cause interference, move them away from your keyboard and receiver.
- Do not modify or tamper with your keyboard's internal components. It may cause a malfunction and invalidate the warranty.
- Use and store the keyboard only in room temperature environments.
- Keep the keyboard dry; if it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.

- Keep the keyboard away from dust and dirt, and wipe it with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.
- Handle the keyboard carefully; do not drop it.
