- If you do not plan to use your keyboard for a long time, slide 0 switch to **OFF** (red) to save battery power.

Sleep Mode

Your keyboard enters sleep mode if left idle for 10 minutes or if you unplug the receiver from your USB port. To reactivate your keyboard, press any key (not the touchpad area) or reconnect the receiver (if unplugged).

Windows 8 Functions

Troubleshooting

pairing is successful.

you have difficulty pairing your touchpad keyboard with your omputer, or if you have difficulty using the gesture controls:

- Make sure you have properly installed fresh batteries.
- Pair the keyboard and receiver again:
- 1 Place the keyboard within 2 inches of the receiver
- 2. Press and hold **Right/Ctrl** for 2 seconds then slide the U switch to ON (green). Release the Right/Ctrl button. The power indicator immediately flashes once when
- The power indicator flashes in 5 seconds if pairing fails. Receiver.
- 3. If pairing fails, switch the 0 switch **OFF** (red), then repeat pairing steps.

mportant Information

- Do not place the keyboard or the receiver on a metal surface. Metal may impair the RF communication.
- For optimal performance, place the keyboard closer to the receiver.
- Do not place the receiver on the top of computer, wireless router, or monitor to avoid interference.
- If nearby RF devices cause interference, move them away from your keyboard and receiver.
