

"L-D-C" (Long Distance Call)

Appears on the upper left hand side, when the incoming call is a long distance call and the service is provided by your local telephone company,

Caller List

Records call information for up to 80 incoming calls such as caller's name and telephone number together with the date and time of the call. After recording a new incoming call, the NEW CALL indicator will blink and the display will look as shown below:





Viewing the Caller List


- Press the SCROLL DÓWN button to view the latest record, or press the SCROLL UP button to view the first record, press the SHIFT RIGHT button if the name has more than 11 digits.
- Press the button to go back to STANDBY mode. (If no active buttons are pressed for 20 seconds or you have viewed the last record in the Caller's List, the LCD Screen will automatically return to STANDBY mode.)

Placing a Call from the Caller List

- Press the SCROLL DOWN button to select from the latest record, or press the SCROLL UP button to select from the first record.
- Press and hold down the 7-DIGIT button for a local call, or the 10-DIGIT pressed button for a local call with area code, or the 1+ button for a long distance call.
- To end your conversation, either press the button or place the HANDSET on the BASE UNIT.

To place a call from the Caller List in TALK mode, press the sals button, then follow steps 1 to 3.


NOTE: You can edit the number before dialing.



Editing the Caller List before Dialing

- Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to find the caller.
- 2. Press the Masivedit button.
- 3. Move the cursor by pressing the SHIFT LEFT or RIGHT button to the digit you want to change. To erase digits, press the scander button. To add digits, use the TELEPHONE KEYPAD population buttons.
- 4. Press and hold down the 7-DIGIT button for a local call, or the 10-DIGIT Doperate button for a local call with area code, or the 1+ button for a long distance call.
- To end your conversation, either press the button or place the HANDSET on the BASE UNIT.


To save the edited record from the Caller List, follow steps 1 to 3 then press and hold down the repassive button.



Saving the Name and Number in the Caller List into the DIRECTORY

- Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to find the caller.
- 2. Press and hold down the in palsave button.

NOTE: It is not advisable to save a telephone number without the corresponding name. This will lead to improper display on Private and Out of Area calls.

Deleting All Records in the Caller List


- 1. Press and hold down the scanded button at the STANDBY mode.
- The LCD Screen will automatically return to STANDBY mode.

Selective Deleting in the Caller List

- Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to find the caller at STANDBY mode.
- Press and hold down the scandel button, then the LCD Screen will display the next item in the Caller List.
- Press the button to return to STANDBY mode.

Name and Telephone Number DIRECTORY

This DIRECTORY lets you scroll through the list to find the person you need for one touch dialing. You can store up to 40 names and telephone numbers in the Memory.



Viewing the DIRECTORY


1. Press the button.

Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to find the one you need, press the SHIFT RIGHT button if the name or telephone number is more than 11 digits.

NOTE: To exit the DIRECTORY List at anytime, press the **DIRECTORY** button.

Speed viewing the DIRECTORY

- 1. Press the button.
- Enter the first letter of a name. (See page 35 for detail of entering a letter.)
- 3. Press the SCROLL DOWN button to find all names with the same first letter.



Saving in the DIRECTORY

- 1. Press the button.
- 2. Press the plastified button.
- Use the TELEPHONE KEYPAD Moperation

 buttons to enter the name, (see page 35 for detail) you can store up to 18 characters.
- Press the SCROLL DOWN button once.
- Enter the telephone number using the TELEPHONE KEYPAD Dioperate - Story button. You can store up to 22 digits.
- 6. Press and hold down the repaisave button.
- Press the button to return to STANDBY mode. (If no active buttons are pressed for 20 seconds, the LCD Screen will automatically return to STANDBY mode.

NOTE: It will not save a duplicate telephone number or a name without the corresponding telephone number in the DIRECTORY.

PREFERRED CALLS

You can assign PREFERRED CALL which will generate a special ringer sound at the start of the second ring to any welcome caller in the DIRECTORY. When you are saving the name and number into the DIRECTORY, add a "#" mark at the beginning of the name by pressing the TELEPHONE KEYPAD #155 button.

BLOCKED CALLS


You can assign a BLOCKED CALL which will disable the ringer sound from the second ring to any caller in the DIRECTORY. When you are saving the name and number into the DIRECTORY, add an "*" mark at the beginning of the name by pressing the TELEPHONE KEYPAD *** button.




Editing the Name and Number in the DIRECTORY

- 1. Press the button.
- 2. Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to find the record you want to edit.
- 3. Press the destredit button to edit the
- 4. Press the SHIFT LEFT W or RIGHT button to move the cursor to the letter or number you want to change. To erase, press the scan/del button. To add, use the TELEPHONE KEYPAD COOTED www buttons. (See page 35 for details.)
- 5. Press the SCROLL UP ar DOWN button to edit the number.
- 6. Press the SHIFT LEFT or RIGHT button to move the cursor to the number you want to change. To erase, press the scandel button. To add, use the TELEPHONE KEYPAD DODET 0 - 9 WXY buttons. (See page 35 for details.)
- 7. Press and hold down the reloalsave button to confirm.

IMPORTANT: It is not advisable to save a telephone number without the corresponding name in the DIRECTORY. This will lead to improper displays on Private and Out of Area calls.


NOTE: When no active buttons are pressed for 20 seconds, the LCD Screen will automatically return to STANDBY mode.



Editing the Number in the DIRECTORY before Dialing


- 1. Press the die button.



- To end your conversation, either press the button or place the HANDSET on the BASE UNIT.



Deleting All Records in the DIRECTORY




To access, press the button at STANDBY mode, then press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD buttons or the SCROLL DOWN button.




A. LANGUAGE

This telephone offers English, Spanish and French languages for your convenience.

- 1. Press the June voice male button.
- 2. Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the Redivitash button.
- 4. Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to select the language you desire. You can also set the language by pressing the following TELEPHONE KEYPAD buttons; for English, of Spanish, or Spa
- 5. Press and hold down the saverega button.
- Press the <u>functionermal</u> button to return to STANDBY mode.





B. SILENT-ON/OFF

This telephone will generate the first ring sound even in the BLOCKED CALL mode to indicate that you have an incoming call. To keep silent in the BLOCKED CALL mode, you can turn off the first ring sound.

- 1. Press the wire second button.
- Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the coldiast button.
- 4. Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to select the SILENT ON/OFF setting. You can also press the TELE-PHONE KEYPAD buttons; for ON or for OFF. SILENT OFF is the preset mode.
- 5. Press and hold down the saveners button.
- Press the duncyoce mall button to return to STANDBY mode.


C. TIME SET


Set the date and time.

- 1. Press the suncyoice mall button.
- 2. Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the edivision button.
- 4. Use the TELEPHONE KEYPAD buttons

 Operator Sway to enter the month,
 date, hour and minute. The cursor moves
 automatically after entering each item.
 Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD
 button for AM setting, or press the
 TELEPHONE KEYPAD button for
 PM setting.
- 5. Press and hold down the save/repa button.
- **6.** Press the **frunc/volce/mail** button to return to STANDBY mode.

NOTE: The date and time will automatically set, if you have subscribed to the Caller ID service from your local telephone company.





D. RINGER VOLUME


This function enables you to adjust the ringer volume from HI, LOW and OFF as desired.


- 1. Press the function button.
- 2. Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the editifiastic button.
- 4. Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to adjust the ringer volume suitable for your convenience. You can also adjust the ringer volume by pressing the following TELEPHONE KEYPAD buttons; for OFF, 200 for HI, or 300 for LOW. HI is the preset ringer volume.
- 5. Press and hold down the saverepa button.
- Press the <u>functional</u> button to return to STANDBY mode.

E. LCD CONTRAST

This unit enables you to select 8 brightness levels for the Large LCD Screen.

- 1. Press the functione mail button.
- 2. Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the edivitash button.
- Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to adjust the brightness of the LCD Screen. Level 4 is the preset brightness.
- 5. Press and hold down the savetre/pa button.
- Press the <u>fundvoice malls</u> button to return to STANDBY mode.





F. PBX NUMBER

This unit will automatically operate in the PBX MODE ON system. You can preset the PBX number (such as an 8 or 9) while you are using a switchboard system or you can turn the PBX system to OFF.

- 1. Press the duncholes mail button.
- 2. Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the redivitation button.
- Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button. (9 is the preset PBX number.)
 PBX MODE OFF set for direct line access.
- 5. Press and hold down the average button.
- Press the <u>Functionermal</u> button to return to STANDBY mode.

NOTE: When placing a call, this telephone will automatically add the PBX number and a pause time before the dialed telephone numbers.

G. FLASH TIME

This unit enables you to select the standard FLASH TIME applicable to your calling area. If you are not sure of the FLASH TIME you are using, call your local telephone company.

- 1. Press the functione mall button.
- Press the TELEPHONE KEYPAD button.
- 3. Press the edivilash button.
- 4. Press the SCROLL UP or DOWN button to select the FLASH TIME. You can also set the FLASH TIME by entering the FLASH TIME number using the TELEPHONE KEYPAD **DOBATO** **DOWN** Duttons. The preset FLASH TIME is 600 milliseconds.
- 5. Press and hold down the saverage button.
- 6. Press the function to return to STANDBY mode.
