- 1. Insert battery into MEGA FREE.
- 2. Install MEGA FREE at your car's sun-visor.

STEP 2

3. Take up the pincers of your phone speaker.

STEP 3

- 4. Peel off the paper from double-sided tape at the back of the metal sticker.
- 5. Stick the metal sticker firmly to the center of the battery at the back of the cellular phone.

STEP 4

- 6. Attach the cellular phone to the MEGA FREE.
- 7. Set your FM frequency to 88.3MHz in your car audio.

 - 2. Press send button on your cellular unit to receive phone call.
 - 3. Make handset and radio volume adjustments as in "Making a call" above.
 - 4. Turn off the phone after conversation.
