I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that the device appears to be sufficiently large to contain the 2-condition statement. Please explain how this device meets the exclusions of 15.19(a)(5).

Response: In the photographs, the device appears larger than it actually is. In addition to being quite small in size, the EUT also has very little suitable area for label placement, due to its shape, and all its fittings/openings. After the FCC ID label, the little available space is utilized for critical safety information. Additionally, typical installations, such as chemical tanks, include hazardous conditions; the manufacturer prefers to limit the number of labels.

2. Please note that while I can make assumptions about where the antenna and/or antenna leads are in the schematics, they are in German. Please clearly identify the antenna in the schematics.

Response: Please refer to the revised schematic exhibit uploaded with this response. The antenna connector is shown on page 5 of the pdf file; a note has been added to the right side of the page to indicate its location.
