Note: Battery life may vary depending on external conditions, handling, control range etc.


Caution

- Do not over-charge the battery, if the battery becomes too hot to touch while charging then remove from charging immediately and leave it to cool, otherwise battery may get damaged.

- Do not disassemble or reconstruct the battery.
- Do not connect the battery to an electrical outlet.

OPERATION



Extend the transmitter's antenna for better signal reception. Move the ON/OFF switch on the mini racer to ON, and place it on the ground.



2. Transmitter

- a. The signal indicator lights up when any button on the transmitter is pressed.
- b. The mini racer runs forward and headlights will light up when the transmitter's forward button is pressed. The mini racer runs reverse and lights up its tail lamps when the transmitter's reverse button is pressed.
- c. Mini racer car will turn left/right on pressing the left/ right button on the transmitter.



The directional guide is used to adjust the mini racer's directline-running-performance.



NOTICE

- 1. The control distance will be shorten when the mini racer is under low power condition.
- 2. If the mini racer gets damaged, deformed, please repair it in time. If the rotor becomes damaged or broken, DO NOT play, otherwise, it will lead to injury.
- If you don't use the transmitter for a long time. Remove all the batteries out, in order to avoid battery leakage to damage this product.
- Don't drop the mini racer from high positions or crash it seriously, because that will damage it seriously or shorten the usage time.
