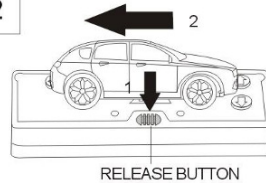
PREPARATION

1



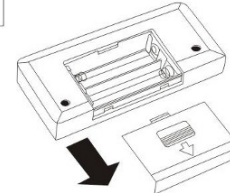
Open the can, detach the can cover from the can. Push the LOCK inside the can cover towards the direction shown to release the 4 Road blocks.

2



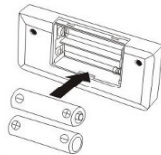
Take out the transmitter and the mini racer from the can. Press the RELEASE button. Slide the mini racer in the direction shown to release it.

Slide the transmitter's battery compartment cover towards the direction shown to open it.

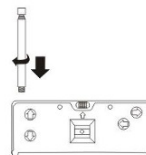

Install 2 AA batteries according to the polarities indicated.

- Do not mix new and old batteries.
- Don't mix different types of batteries.

Insert and tighten the antenna on the antenna hole of the transmitter.

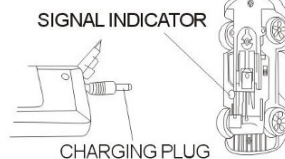
CHARGING THE MINI RACER

1



Open the charge cover and remove the charging Cable, insert in the transmitter.

2



Insert the charging plug to the charging jack on the bottom of the mini racer, the charging indicator lights up to indicate the charging is in process.

3



Charging takes about 3 minutes, the mini racer is fully charged when the charging indicator goes off and it runs for about 6-10 minutes.

Note: Battery life may vary depending on external conditions, handling, control range etc.

Caution

- If the racer needs to recharge, please wait for 10-15 minutes.
- Do not over-charge the battery, if the battery becomes too hot to touch while charging then remove from charging immediately and leave it to cool, otherwise battery may get damaged.
- Always pay attention to when you are charging the battery.
- Do not disassemble or reconstruct the battery.
- Do not connect the battery to an electrical outlet.

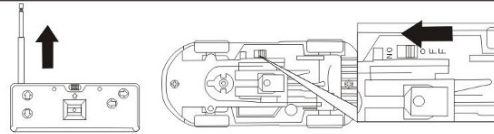

OPERATION

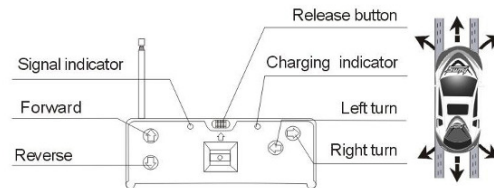
1.

Extend the transmitter's antenna for better signal reception. Move the ON/OFF switch on the mini racer to ON, and place it on the ground.



2. Transmitter

- a. The signal indicator lights up when any button on the transmitter is pressed.
- b. The mini racer runs forward and headlights will light up when the transmitter's forward button is pressed. The mini racer runs reverse and lights up its tail lamps when the transmitter's reverse button is pressed.
- c. Mini racer car will turn left/right on pressing the left/right button on the transmitter.

The directional guide is used to adjust the mini racer's direct-line-running-performance.



NOTICE

1. The control distance will be shorten when the mini racer is under low power condition.
2. If the mini racer gets damaged, deformed, please repair it in time. If the rotor becomes damaged or broken, DO NOT play, otherwise, it will lead to injury.
3. If you don't use the transmitter for a long time. Remove all the batteries out, in order to avoid battery leakage to damage this product.
4. Don't drop the mini racer from high positions or crash it seriously, because that will damage it seriously or shorten the usage time.
