After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) The 731 form no longer contains DSS and JBP equipment codes. I believe this should contain PCE, JBP, DSS codes. Please verify.
- 2) I do not see how you obtained the powers listed on the 731. Max ERP for 800 MHz appears on page 32 of the report 22.6 dBm (182 mW), contrary to the 22.4 dBm listed on pages 8 and 26. Max EIRP for 1900 MHz appears on page 27 of the report 24.5 dBm (282 mW).
- 3) Your answer regarding simultaneous TX does not appear to agree with plots given in the test report. Please review.
- 4) Please provide theory of operation for the Bluetooth as previously discussed.
