To Switch Your Phone On/Off

- ✓ Press and Hold "PWR" for about 2 seconds Until you hear a beep You will see your phone number on display screen
 - ⇒ Display screen will show a greeting, date and time
 - ⇒ You can customize this greeting and see display screen menu at "MNU+3+2"
- ✓ If keypad lock is on, the screen will ask for your Lock Code
- ✓ When your 4 digit Lock Code is entered, you will see the display screen with greeting, date and time (the default Lock Code is set as 0000) Emergency calls button such as 911 and "i" key will be available even with keypad lock on
- ✓ To turn you phone off, press and hold "PWR" for about 2 seconds

To make a call

- ✓ Enter the number including the area code
- ✓ Press "TALK"
- ✓ To End a call, press "END" (When a call is ended, call time will be displayed for about 2 seconds)
 - ⇒ If you make a mistake entering a number, Press "CLR" to delete the last number or press and hold "CLR" to clear the entire numbers
 - ⇒ Volume can be controlled with [side-down] key (only during a call)
 - ⇒ When you are not making a call [side-down] key will control key tone volume

Speed Dial

- ✓ For memory location 0-9, Press and hold the memory location number for longer than 1 sec
- ✓ For memory location 10-99, Press the first digit as normal and then press and hold the second digit for longer than 1 sec

To answer a call 💮 🚜

- ✓ Press any key, except "PWR"
- ✓ To end a call, press "END"
- ✓ Call time will be displayed for about 2 secs after your end the call
 - ⇒ If a call was not answered, incoming phone number and called time will be displayed (Caller ID) if you press "TALK" at this display The phone will dial the displayed number

To send your number instantly (When paging someone)

✓ Press MNU+1: This sends your number to the pager automatically(only during a call)

Memo (To enter a number or other data during a call)

- ✓ Press MNU+3 (only during a call)
- ✓ User keypad to enter or edit memo (The key tone will not be heard by the person at the other side)
- ✓ Press "STO"
 - ⇒ To confirm or see stored memo see "Personal memo" (MNU+1+7)

Mute William Control of the Control

- ✓ Press NMU+4 to activate mute
- ✓ Press MNU+4 again to deactivate mute

Emergency Call

- ✓ Press "i" for longer than 1 sec
- ✓ To store a number in "i" memory location Press MNU+1+5

MNU-1: Memory Binction

1. To see call time

- 1:To See Last Call Time
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+1+1
- 2:To See All Call Time
 - **⇒** Press MNU+1+1+2
- 3:To See Home Are Call Time
 - ⇒ Press **MNU**+1+1+3
- 4:To See Roaming Are Call Time
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+1+4

2. To See World Time

- ⇒ Press MNU+1+2
- ⇒ Select a desired city by using "**A***/**V**#"
- ⇒ Press "STO" To view time at selected city

3. To Store Phone Numbers into memory location

- ⇒ Press MNU+1+3
- ⇒ The screen will display "Number?" Enter the phone number to store and press "STO"
- The screen will show empty memory location such as "Default : 00" Use($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown \#$) to select—wanted empty memory location and press "STO"
- ⇒ The screen will show "Name?" Enter the name and press "STO"
 - To store a number while standing by or during a call Enter a number and press "STO" The screen will show an empty memory location (follow above)

4. Memory Search

- 1:Outgoing Call Viewing
 - **⇒** Press MNU+1+4+1
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to view last outgoing 10 called numbers
- 2:Incoming Call Viewing
 - **⇒** Press MNU+1+4+2
 - ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to view last incoming 10 called numbers
- 3:Name Search
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+4+3
 - ⇒ When display shows "Name?" Enter name and press "STO"
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select other names
- 4:Phone Number Search
 - ⇒ Press **NMU+1+4+4**
 - ⇒ When "Number?" is displayed on the screen, enter the number and press "STO"
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select other numbers
- 5: Memory location search
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+4+5
 - ⇒ Select Location Number The screen will display "Location" enter the location number
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select other locations

5. To store Emergency number "i" key

- ⇒ Press MNU+1+5
- The screen will show current number stored under "i" key If this number needs to be replaced, enter a new number and press "STO"
- Or while standing by, enter the number and press "i", the screen will ask if you want to replace the number

⇒ Select "Yes" to replace the number

6. To Clear Memory

- 1:To Clean Outgoing Call List
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+6+1
 - The screen will show "Outgoing Call?" Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown\#$) to select "Yes" or "No" and press "STO"
- 2:To Clean Incoming Call List
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+6+2
 - ⇒ The screen will show "Incoming Call?" Use (▲*/▼#) to select "Yes" or "No" and press "STO"
- 3:To Clean All Memory
 - ⇒ Press MNU+1+6+3
 - □ The screen will show "Clean All Memory?" Use (▲*/▼#) to toggle between "Yes" or "No" and press "STO"

7. To See Personal Memo

⇒ You can view personal memo entered during a call by pressing MNU+1+7

MNU+2: Call Setting

1. Ring Volume

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 2 + 1
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to toggle between Level 1 to Level 5
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired Ring volume

2. Ring Type

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 2 + 2
- \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to toggle between Bell 1 to 4 and Melody 1 to 6
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired ring type

3. Automatic Re-dial

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 2 + 3
- \Rightarrow Use (\blacktriangle */ \blacktriangledown #) to toggle between desired time (off / 5sec / 10sec)
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired time

4. Auto Answer

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 2 + 4
- ⇒ To select number of rings before handset Automatically answer a call
- Arr Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to toggle between number of rings (Off / 1~4 Rings)
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired number

5. Hands free Volume Control

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 2 + 5
- \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to toggle between Volumes Lever 1 to 5
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired Level

MNU+3: Phone Setting

1. Back Light Function

- 1:Back light duration
 - ⇒ Press MNU+3+1+1
 - ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to toggle and select duration (Always off / 5sec / 10 sec / Always on)
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired duration

2:Back Light Color

- ⇒ Press MNU+3+1+2
- □ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle color (Yellow / Green)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired color

2. Editing Greeting

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 2
- ⇒ When the screen shows "Greeting?" Edit the Greeting
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Greeting

3. Call Volume

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 3
- \Rightarrow Use ($\triangle */\nabla \#$) to select / toggle Call Volume (Level 1 ~ 5)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Call volume

4. Key Tone Volume

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 4
- \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to select / toggle Key Tone Volume (Silent/Level 1 ~ 4)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Key Tone Volume

5. Key Tone Length

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 5
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Key Tone Length (Short / Continuance)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Key tone Length

6. DTMF Tone Length

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 6
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle DTMF Tone Length (Short(100m sec)/Long(500m sec))
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired DTMF Tone Length

7. Power up melody

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3+ 7
- \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to select / toggle Power up melody (Off / Melody 1~6)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Power up melody

8. Language Setting

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 8
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Language Setting (English / Spanish)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Language

9. LCD Contrast Setting

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 3 + 9
- \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select / toggle Contrast Setting (Level 1~5)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Contrast

MNU + 4 : Security

1. Automatic Phone Lock

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 1
- ⇒ This Feature locks the phone and requires a code upon or power up
- \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select / toggle On / Off
- ⇒ Press "STO" after selecting desired Function

2. Lock code change

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 2
- ⇒ Edit / Enter new number

⇒ Press "STO" to select desired number

3. Call Restriction

- 1:Restricting Incoming Call
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 1
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function
- 2: Restricting Outgoing Call
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 2
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function
- 3:Restricting Memory Call
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 3
 - \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function
- 4:Restricting International Calls
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 4
 - \Rightarrow Use (\triangle */ ∇ #) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function
- 5: Restricting Long Distance Calls
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 5
 - \Rightarrow Use ($\triangle */\nabla \#$) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function
- 6:Restricting No. "900-xxx-xxxx" Calls
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 3 + 6
 - \Rightarrow Use ($\triangle */\nabla \#$) to select / toggle On / Off
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function

4. Phone Reset

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 4
- ⇒ To reset the phone to default value
- \Rightarrow Use ($\triangle */\nabla \#$) to select / toggle On / Off
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function

5. PIN Setting

 \Rightarrow Press MNU + 4 + 5

- ⇒ Use (**A***/**V**#) to select / toggle On / Off
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function

MNU+5: Alert Option

1. Service Alert

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 5 + 1
- \Rightarrow Use ($\blacktriangle^*/\blacktriangledown$ #) to select / toggle Setup / Release
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Service Alert

2. Area Change

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 5 + 2
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Setup / Release
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Area Change Alert

3. Call Drop Alert

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 5 + 3
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Setup / Release
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Call Drop Alert

4. 1Min Alert

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 5 + 4
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Setup / Release
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired 1Min talking Alert

5. Roaming Alert

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 5+ 5
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Setup / Release
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Roaming Alert

MNU + 6: System Selection

1. Network

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 6 + 1
- □ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Network Mode (CDMA Only / AMPS Only / CDMA Preferred / AMPS Preferred)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Network Mode

2. AMPS System

 \Rightarrow Press MNU + 6 + 2

- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Mode (A Only / B Only / A Preferred / B Preferred)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired AMPS System

3. CDMA Only

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 6 + 3
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Mode (A Only / B Only / A Preferred / B Preferred)
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired CDMA System

MNU+7: NAM Selection

1. NAM Function

- 1:Manual NAM Selection
 - \Rightarrow Press MNU + 7 + 1
 - ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Nam number (NAM1 / NAM2 / NAM3 / NAM4)
 - ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Nam number

2: Auto NAM Selection

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 7 + 2
- \Rightarrow Use ($\triangle */\nabla \#$) to select / toggle On / Off
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Function

MNU + 8 & Schedule + Alarm 🔭 🔭 💮 💮 💮 💮 💮

1. Alarm Setting

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 8 + 1
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Alarm Type (Off/ Single Alarm/Daily Alarm) and press "STO"
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Time

2. Schedule Setting

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 8 + 2
- ⇔ When the screen shows date edit mode, eater date and press "STO"
- When the date is entered and stored, eater appropriate memo and press "STO" (You can enter upto 10 schedules)

3. Schedule Search

- \Rightarrow Press MNU + 8 + 3
- ⇒ The screen will show stored schedule and its number
- ⇒ Press "STO" to select desired Schedule

MNU + 9: Alert Setting

- □ To Select Ring Type
- ⇒ Press MNU + 9
- ⇒ Use (▲*/▼#) to select / toggle Ring Type
- ⇔ Available Ring type
 - Bell + Lamp
 - **♥** Vibration + Lamp
 - **●** Bell after Vibration
 - **♦** Vibration after Bell
 - **♥** Lamp
