To whom it may concern:

Form 731 has been submitted electronically, initiating the "certification" of the Terion (formerly Flash Comm, Inc.) DHF-2000. This product is a new mobile transceiver that utilizes heretofore under utilized portions of the HF spectrum. The FCC Wireless Telecommunications Bureau granted waivers to Flash Comm, Inc. in 1997 (DA 97-1451) allowing this new and novel wide area wireless data service to be operated in portions of the HF electromagnetic spectrum. The technical parameters associated with "Equipment Type-acceptance Requirements" are delineated in DA 97-1451 Appendix B. Terion has now completed the design and successful testing of the HF transmitting equipment. We are therefore eager to gain certification necessary for full-scale sale and marketing of this new and novel product.

While pursuing the grant of waivers through the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Thomas Stanley (Ph# 202-418-0605) was a valuable technical contact at the FCC.
