

- Turn on the Monster Rod and the controller using the On/Off switches as shown in the Battery Installation and Power On/Off section of this instruction sheet.
- The power indicator light on the controller will glow as long as the battery has power.

Driving Tips:

If you hold the wheel in a turn while driving forward or backwards the Monster Rod will spin out. Practice doing this for quick direction changes.

Remember that when the vehicle is coming towards you, it will steer in the opposite direction to the way you turn the wheel. Try to imagine that you are in the driver's seat to work out the direction it will turn in.

To perform a wheelie, drive in reverse and quickly push the throttle forward. The driver will open his mouth and let out a monstrous laugh as the front wheels lift off the ground.

When you have finished playing, make sure that you turn the On/Off switch on the controller and Monster Rod to "Off".



Safety Precautions

- Never drive your Monster Rod on the streets.
- Do not pick up the vehicle while it is in motion.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires and wheels while the vehicle is in motion. • Do not drive the vehicle through water.
- For best results, hold the antenna up, not pointing down towards the vehicle.
