




- batteries (standard alkaline, or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities. We recommend the use of rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before recharging them.


 • Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult

Driving the Astro-Flex


- Turn on the Jet Car and the controller using the On/Off switches.
- The power indicator light on the controller will glow as long as the battery has power.





































Practice using the Cockpit Up and Down buttons while driving for quick twists, spins, flips and stunts.

Remember that when the vehicle is coming towards you, it will steer in the opposite direction to the way you turn the wheel. Try to imagine that you are in the driver's seat to work out the direction it will turn in.
