

- Read these instructions All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.
- 2. Keep these instructions –The safety and operating instructions should be kept for future reference.
- 3. Heed all warnings All warnings on the appliance and in operating instructions should be adhered to.
- 4. Follow all instructions All operation and use instructions should be followed.
- 5. Do not use this apparatus near water The appliance should not be used near water; for example, near a bath tub, washbowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool.
- 6. Clean only with dry cloth The appliance should be cleaned only as recommended by the manufacturer.
- 7. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. 


- -- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.

Top View




Front View

Charging

There will be a voice sounding "Low Battery" when the battery being out of power.

- 1. Before charging your speaker, slide the ON-OFF switch to the OFF position.
- 2. Insert the micro-USB end of the USB cable (supplied) into the DC 5V power socket on the speaker.
- 3. Slot the other end of the USB cable into either a USB port on a laptop, computer or USB mains plug adaptor.
- 4. The charging light on the the speaker will be red when the speaker is charging.
- 5. When the charging light turns off, the speaker is fully charged, and the USB cable can be removed.

NOTE: Please charge by 5V, 1A power supply.

PLAYING AUDIO VIA BLUETOOTH SOURCE

Selecting BT Mode

- Push the power switch to ON position to power on the unit, the Bluetooth indicator will turn Blue
 and blink, and there is a voice voice tone sounds "Bluetooth Mode", now the unit is in pairing mode.
- ~ The unit will start searching for the device last connected, if the device is found, the unit will reconnect the device automatically.
- ~ Please note, only one Bluetooth device can be connected to the unit at one time.
- Activate Bluetooth on your device (smart phone, tablet, computer, etc.).
- In the Bluetooth menu of your device, there should be an option to search for Bluetooth devices. Select this option.
- ~ Your device will now scan for other Bluetooth device and should find the unit, identified as "SYLVANIA SP606".
- · Choose to pair with "SYLVANIA SP606".
- After successful pairing, there will be a voice tone sounds "Bluetooth device connected".
 After pairing for the first time, the audio system will appear on the connection menu of your Bluetooth device.
- If you want to connect another Bluetooth device to the unit, deactivate the current connection by holding the ►I/J button for around 5 seconds. Follow the steps above to connect the new device.

During playback:

- Press the ►I/J button to change between Play and Pause mode at any time.
- Press ⋈ /- or ⋈ /+ button to select the next or previous track.
- Press the button on the unit to turn on/off the LED lights.

Phone Call Function

- When a call comes in, press ►II/) button to answer.
- During a call, press the ►II/) button to end the call.
- Quickly press the ►II/) button twice to redial the last dialed number.
- When a phone call comes in, press and hold the ►II/) button to reject.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you are having problems with your unit, please review the guide below before requesting.

TROUBLE	POSSIBLE CAUSE	POSSIBLE SOLUTION
No power	The built-battery is out of power	Recharge the battery
No sound	Volume is set to minimum	Increase volume level
	The connected device is not in playing mode	Play the music from the connected device
	Sound output of the connected device is set too low	Increase the volume level of the connected device
Sound distortion	Volume level is too high	Reduce the volume level
	Volume level of the connected device is set too high	Reduce the volume level of the connected device
	The external device is too far from the unit	Put the external BT device close to the unit.
Bluetooth fail to pair	Fail pairing and connection	Pair the unit with BT device as the procedures stated in this manual.
