





Installation instructions

01 Connect to the TV

To enjoy picture quality in high resolution, we recommend you to use HDMI cable to connect iTalkBB set top box to your TV.
If you're not using a high resolution TV, please use AV cable to connect iTalkBB TV set top box to your TV (connecting with either HDMI cable or AV cable)

02 Connect to the internet



iTalkBB TV set top box will automatically turn on once connected to the power





Remote control function




Network settings



- > If you use wireless connection, then enter WIFI settings.
- > If you use wired network, already connect with network cable and network works well, then enter wired network settings.

A. Wireless Connection

- > Select your wifi name from the wireless network list, the lock icon means password needed.
- > Input password and then click "OK", it will automatically enter next step if connected.
- > Also you may manually add a wireless network if needed.



B. Wired Connection

- > Connect iTalkBB TV set top box to internet with a internet cable.
- > Simply click next for automatic configuration, and you're all set. You may also use manual IP configuration by turning on the DHCP button.
