


Connect to the power supply and then it will display the home screen as below picture



#### 2-1 Add screen shortcuts


On the home page, touch and hold the blank area to popup menu to change wallpaper;

# 2-2 Delete screen shortcuts/widgets




#### 3-1-2 Bluetooth
