

To whom reading this letter:

Because of Industrial Design issue, The battery cover is designed with a curve, not flat. It's very difficult to glue the product label on the battery cover reliably and it will be easily fallen off. That's why we glue the product label inside battery housing. But we don't insert the battery into machine and put it into packing box independently for shipping. That means end user should notice FCC ID on product label during he (or she) insert the battery into machine. We hope this explanation can clarify the below question: Per FCC label policy, only cell phone or cordless phone can have label applied inside the battery compartment, all other device need to have a special approval by FCC. Please submit an application letter with reason of why label can not be applied on the surface and we will submit it to the FCC for their approval if desired.
