- 1.) Please upload Test Setup Photos as a separate exhibit for the Tx and Rx units.
- 2.) Please upload manual for the Rx.
- 3.) The transmitter owner's manual identifies 32 channels within the 433 MHz band. Please re-submit 731 for Tx and Rx correcting the frequency range for which you are seeking Grant of Equipment Authorization.
- 4.) Please submit agent authorization letter for both Rx and Tx Application.
- 5.) Please submit functional block diagram for Tx and Rx.
- 6.) Please submit labels for both Tx and Rx. The Tx label in the report is not sufficient – it must include proposed FCC ID:
- 7.) Please provide timing information on the transmitted signal.
- 8.) Please describe the transmitted intelligence impressed on the signal. Be mindful of the prohibitions of 15.231(a).
- 9.) Please provide plot of bandwidth measurement results per 15.231(3)(c)
- 10.) Please submit pictures of back side of PC board for receiver.
- 11.) How is Rx powered? A device that has a DC input but not batteries must connect to the AC powerlines somehow; therefore AC conducted emissions should be included in the test report.
