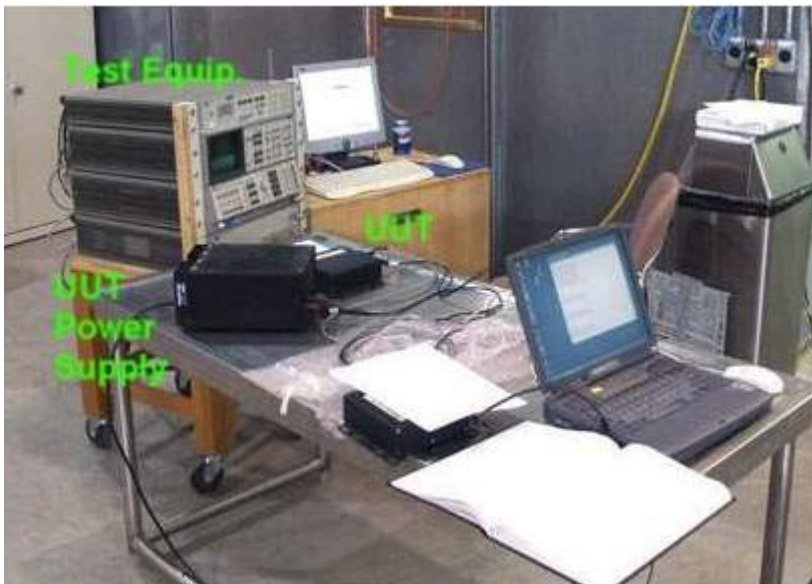


Attached photos are of test setups at ETC.

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Conducted Emission Setup

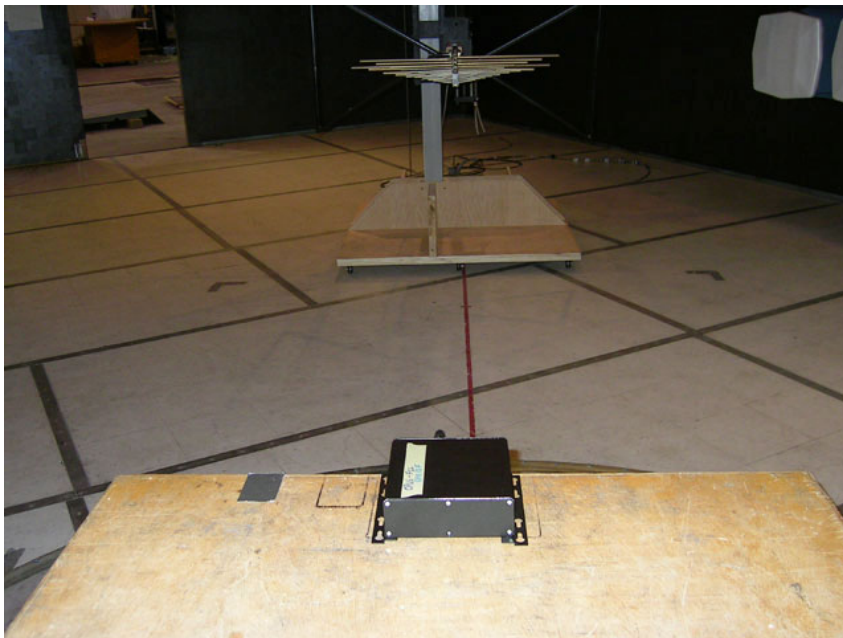


Radiated Emissions Test Setup



Note that Radiated Emission Test has NO ferrites. Internal modification to MMT9000 (added shielded power cable inside unit) reduced emissions sufficiently to pass Class B without ferrites. This modification was done after antenna tests, which is why ferrites appear in the setup photos for the antenna tests.



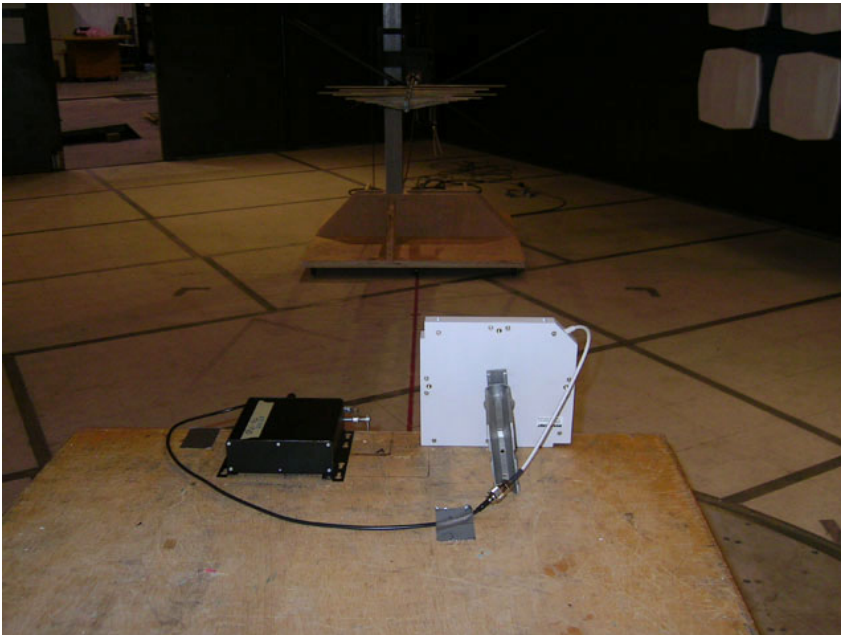


Panel Antenna Test Setup

Chrome Coil Antenna



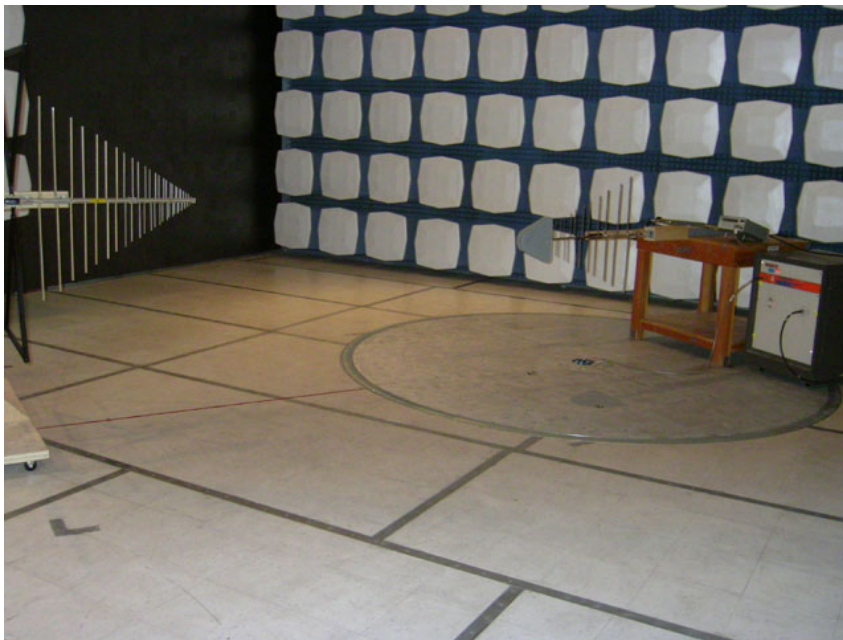
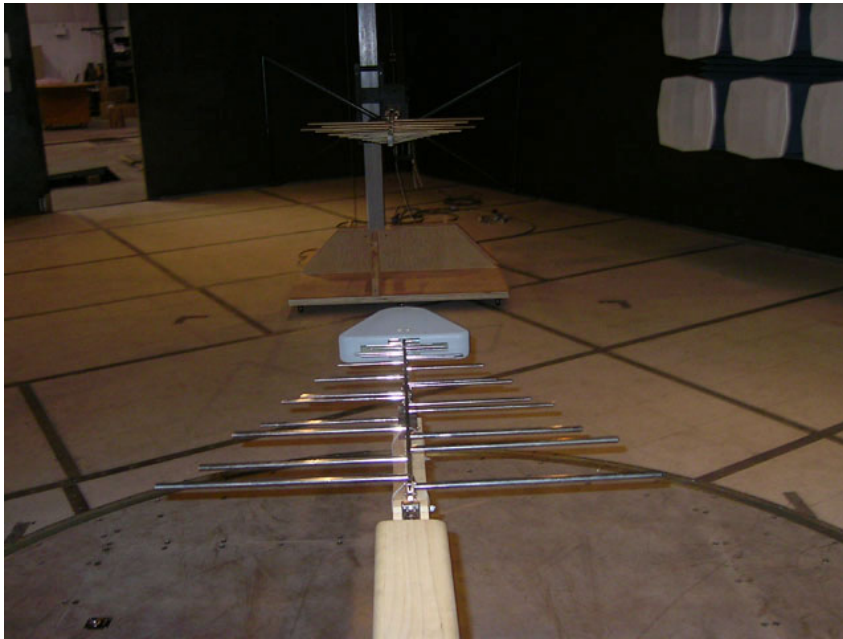
