


Transmitter:

Front panel



- Power switch Press 2 seconds after release to open it, press and hold to close it.
- Channel adjusting upward button
- 3 Channel adjusting down button
- 4 LCD display screen: Display all current used channel
- 6 Left channel audio indicator
- 6 Right channel audio indicator
- The earphone socket
- Monitor output audio level control rotate left output level will reduce. Turn to the right, output level will increase.

Rear panel



- 1 The AC power adapter socket
- 2 Stereo/mono switch Switch letf to mono state. switch the tight transmitting to stereo state.
- 3 The left channel XLR input socket
- 4 The right channel XLR input socket
- **5** The left channel input audio level control
 - Rotary paddle level to reduce, turn to the right to increase.
- 6 The right input audio level control knob Rotary paddle level to reduce, turn to right to increase
