

360T FUNCTIONS




- 1. Gain control Microphone sensitivity adjust
- 2. Mike jack
- 3. LED Indicator Light during nominal operator.

- Off was low battery or Power switch off.

- 4. Power switch On/Mute/Off.
- 5. Channel Select-CHA/CHB.

Operation

- 1. Power switch set to OFF
- 2. Channel select switch set to desired channel
- 3. Make sure the polar of the battery and into the battery compartment as shown below.



- 4. Plugging the microphone into the Mike jack
- 5. Turn ON the power switch / the LED will be light
