
- 1. The 6.4V rechargeable battery pack must be charged before use by utilizing the USB charging cable which included
- 2. Do not overcharge the battery pack. Do not charge for more than 6 hours Do not charge the battery pack if it shows leakage, corrosion, or has loose or
- exposed wires or other damage Do not cover the battery pack with any sort of materials while charging 5. Do not touch the battery pack when it is hot. Wait until the battery pack cools
- before installing it in the Vehicle and before recharging 6. Do not dispose of the battery in fire



- Do not dismantle the battery or charger, and do not cut the battery or USB charging cable
- 8. The battery pack will be warm after charging, and hot after use in a vehicle
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited 10. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged
- 11. Rechargeable batteries for adult charging only
- 12. Battery replacement must be only made by adults
- 13. The USB charging cable is not a toy

- 14. Charge only type (1300mAh Max.) rechargeable battery packs. Other types of batteries may burst causing injury to persons and damage. This power unit is intended to be correctly orientated in a vertical or floor mount position. This USB charging cable is intended to be used for charging 6.4V rechargeable battery pack with capacity 1300mAh Max. It cannot be used for charging non-rechargeable batteries. Regular examination of USB charging cable for any damage to their cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and that, in the event of such damage, it must not be used with the USB charging cable or battery pack charge until such damage has been repaired. Note that the 9V battery is non-rechargeable and is not to be recharged. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. It will need replacement when transmission is poor.
- 15. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
- 16. Chargers used with the toy are to be regularly examined for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and that, in the event of such damage, the toy must not be used with the charger until the damage has been repaired. The Toy is only to be connected to Class II or class III equipment bearing either of the following


Battery Installation














For Transmitter (Fig.6 and Fig.7) Switch OFF the power

- Unscrew the screw on the battery cover
- Open the battery cover

- Install 1 new 9V battery with correct polarity (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment
- Close the battery cover
- 6. Tighten the screw on the battery cover

Charging the Rechargeable Battery Pack for the Vehicle:

- Connect the 6.4V rechargeable battery pack to USB charging cable
- 2. Plug the USB charging cable into the equipment of class II or class III
- The charging time for a full charge is about 3 hours
- When charging is completed, unplug the USB charging cable
- 5. Disconnect the rechargeable battery pack from the USB charging cable

Start To Play

To Match the signal of the Vehicle and Transmitter

- Make sure the Vehicle and Transmitter are installed with batteries.
- Switch ON the Vehicle
- 3. Push the forward stick and hold it in forward position, and switch ON the Transmitter
- 4. The skis of the Vehicle will turn left and right, to show that the signal matching between the Vehicle and Transmitter is completed.
- 5. To avoid interference to the signal matching process, please make sure there is no other 2.4GHz device operating in the same area during the process.
- 6. If the Vehicle is matched with more than one Transmitter, or more than one Vehicles are matched with one Transmitter. Just repeat the matching procedures and make sure only one Vehicle and one Transmitter is switched ON in the signal matching process.

How to Play

- 1. Switch ON the Vehicle
- 2. Use the Forward / Backward joystick (Fig.6) to drive the Vehicle forward
- 3. Use the Left / Right joystick (Fig.6) to control the Vehicle turning left or right.
- 4. If the vehicle does not run in straight line, adjust the Direction Adjustment on the vehicle chassis
- Play on smooth surface to have the optimum performance.
- 6. Remember to switch OFF the power of the Vehicle and Transmitter after
- The optimum control range is up to 35m outdoor.

Performance Tips

- 1. Do not drive on dirt, sand, dusts or go through water
- Do not drive in windy or rainy weather
- Avoid direct impact the Vehicle with obstacles
- 4. Switch OFF the power when not in use to prevent damage of Vehicle and Transmitter due to leakage of electrolyte from batteries
- Remove all batteries from the Vehicle and Transmitter when not in use for long period
- 6. Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from wheels, belt, skis
- 7. The operating range can be affected by a variety of factors a) Low Voltage of batteries in Transmitter or Vehicle
- b) Interference from other items that emit radio frequency signals
- 8. Outdoor usage is recommended in order to get optimum control range
- 9. Recommend to play the vehicle on a clean and smooth surface
- 10. Clean the battery compartment to make sure it is free from dust to prevent poor contact of batteries

- Do not attempt to disassemble the Vehicle or Transmitter
- Make sure the batteries are installed with correct polarities (+/-) as shown inside the
