## **Analysis Report**

The Equipment Under Test (EUT) is a portable 2.4GHz Pure Transmitter (Controller Unit) for a RC Car operating from 2405-2475MHz with 1MHz channel spacing. The EUT is powered by 2 X 1.5V AAA batteries. After switch on the EUT, the RC Car can be controlled to move forward, backward, turning left/right direction by the EUT.

Antenna Type: External integral antenna Antenna Gain: 0dBi Nominal rated field strength: 90.8dBµV/m at 3m Maximum allowed field strength of production tolerance: +/- 3dB

According to the KDB 447498:

Based on the Maximum allowed field strength of production tolerance was 93.8dB $\mu$ V/m at 3m in frequency 2.4GHz, thus;

The EIRP =  $[(FS*D)^{2*1000} / 30] = 0.72 \text{mW}$ 

Conducted power = Radiated Power (EIRP) – Antenna Gain So;

Conducted Power =0.72mW.

The SAR Exclusion Threshold Level: = 3.0 \* (min. test separation distance, mm) / sqrt(freq. in GHz) = 3.0 \* 5 / sqrt (2.475) mW = 9.53 mW

Since the above conducted output power is well below the SAR Exclusion threshold level, so the EUT is considered to comply with SAR requirement without testing.
