>You are listed as the Technical Contact for the above referenced TCB application. The following item(s) need(s) to be resolved before the review can be continued:

>

>1. In order to issue a permissive change to add the conducted RF Output power to the grant, you must submit an MPE calculation which must document the maximum antenna gain allowed in each band to meet both the RF Exposure MPE limits at 20cm separation and the Maximum ERP/EIRP limit. The Grant note will be changed to look something like this:
>Class II Permissive Change to list Conducted Power.

>Output power listed above is ERP for Part 22 and EIRP for Part 24. The Conducted RF Output Power is x.x Watts for Part 22 and x.x Watts for Part 24. Use in mobile configurations can use a maximum x dBi gain antenna, including cable loss, and must be installed to provide a minimum of 20 cm separation to all persons. The antenna(s) used for this transmitter must not be co-located or must not operate in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter within a host device. End-users must be provided with specific information required to satisfy RF exposure compliance for all final host devices.

>

>The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal and forfeiture of the filing fee. Also, please note that partial responses increase processing time and should not be submitted.
