RF Safety Exposure Per FCC Requirement

The Maximum Permissible Exposure (MPE) distance per ANSI C95.1, table 2 for uncontrolled Environments is f (MHz)/1500 [mW/cm 2]. The maximum output power for the pager is 2000 mW and for the LAN radio is 1000 mW. The numerical value of the gain for both antennas is 4 (6dBi). Therefore, the power density is:

[(2000 mW + 1000 mW) x 4.0]/(4

 r²) = 900 MHz/1500 [mW/cm²]
r = [(900 MHz/1500 mW/cm²) (4 π) / 3000 mW]^{1/2}
r = 50.1 cm or 19.7 in

Therefore, the maximum calculated MPE distance (r) is 51 cm. The installation instructions shall indicate that at least 53 cm (51+2 margin) separation be provided between the antennas and the people.
