TEST PROCEDURE

GENERAL: This report shall NOT be reproduced except in full without the written approval of TIMCO ENGINEERING, INC.

RADIATION INTERFERENCE: The test procedure used was ANSI STANDARD C63.4-1992 using a HEWLETT PACKARD spectrum analyzer with a preselector. The bandwidth of the spectrum analyzer was 100 kHz with an appropriate sweep speed. The analyzer was calibrated in dB above a microvolt at the output of the antenna. The resolution bandwidth was $100 \, \text{KHz}$ and the video bandwidth was $300 \, \text{KHz}$. The ambient temperature of the UUT was $70 \, ^{\circ}$ with a humidity of $80 \, ^{\circ}$.

FORMULA OF CONVERSION FACTORS: The Field Strength at 3m was established by adding the meter reading of the spectrum analyzer (which is set to read in units of dBuV) to the antenna correction factor supplied by the antenna manufacturer. The antenna correction factors are stated in terms of dB. The gain of the Preselector was accounted for in the Spectrum Analyzer Meter Reading.

Example:

SAMPLE CALCULATION: FSdBuV/m = MR(dBuV) + ACFdB.

TEST PROCEDURE: The procedure used was ANSI STANDARD C63.4-1992. The spectrum was scanned from 30 MHz to 1000 MHz. When an emission was found, the table was rotated to produce the maximum signal strength. The antenna was placed in both the horizontal and vertical planes and the worse case emissions were reported. The UUT was tested in 3 orthogonal planes.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT: A small sample of the transmitter output was fed into the spectrum analyzer and the attached plot was taken. The vertical scale is set to $-10~\mathrm{dBm}$ per division. The horizontal scale is set to $10~\mathrm{kHz}$ per division.
