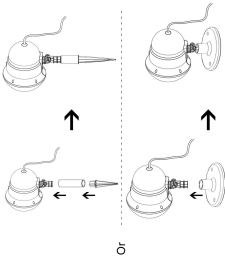

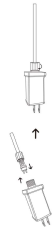

INSTALLATION

 3. Press and hold the button 2s to turn off the lights.

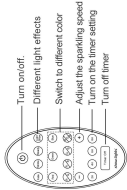
PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Button Function

- Press and hold the button more than 2 seconds slide the battery cover off.
- Insert Battery AAA*2pcs.
WARNING: This is not a toy and is not intended for use by children.
 (A) Do not dispose of the battery in fire as the battery may leak and explode.
 (B) Do not mix old and new batteries and not mix alkaline, standard(carbon-zinc), lithium, or NiMH batteries.
