

# **Installing Hardware**

#### General Installation:

Step 1: Insert 2 x AAA batteries into Keyboard and 2 x AAA batteries into Mouse.

Step 2: Remove the Nano Dongle from the keyboard and then plug the Nano Dongle directly into your PC USB port.

Step 3: Switch the ON/OFF button to power on the keyboard and mouse. Then the keyboard and mouse will automatically connect to the Nano Dongle plugged into your computer.

# **Help with Setup**

Keyboard

If the keyboard does not work properly, it must be paired again.

Pairing as follows:

Step 1: Unplug and Plug the Nano Dongle again.

Step 2: Switch ON the power at the bottom of Keyboard.

Step 3: Press the Pairing button at the bottom of keyboard, or Press Esc & K Keys at the same time within 15 seconds.

In case this takes more than 15 seconds you will need unplug and plug Nano Dongle to repeat the above operation.



# LED Indicator on keyboard:

Definition	Indicator	Description
Pairing	Flashing 3~8 seconds	To indicate Keyboard pairing status when power on the keyboard
Battery low	Flashing once every 3 seconds	To indicate battery low status

Sleep Mode: Keyboard will turn to sleep mode if not used after 5 minutes. Press any key to wake up the keyboard.

Mouse

If the Mouse does not work properly, it must be to paired again.

Pairing as follows:

Step 1: Plug the receiver in.

Step 2: Switch ON the power at the bottom of Mouse.

Step 3: Press the Middle & Right Keys on the Mouse at the same time within 15 seconds. In case this takes more than 15 seconds you will need unplug and plug Nano Dongle to repeat the above operation.

DPI: Reset Default 1500 DPI

Press Middle & Left Kevs at the Mouse same time

To change 1500 / 2000 / 1000 DPI

**Sleep Mode:** Mouse will turn to sleep mode if not used after 8 minutes. Move mouse to wake up the mouse.

# **Trouble Shooting Guide**

If your device does not respond to your Keyboard or mouse there may be a simple explanation such as a dead battery, wrong orientation of installation of batteries or an unsuccessful pairing.

Please use the following to help troubleshoot your situation.

- · Make sure the Power Switch at the bottom of Keyboard and mouse are set to ON.
- Make sure the batteries are installed in the correct orientation, correct +/-.
- Restart your device and re-pairing your Keyboard or mouse per instruction above.
- Turn your Keyboard off and back to on. You should see the LED status lights illuminate briefly, if not, please change batteries.
- Is the USB receiver securely plugged into a computer port? Try moving the Nano dongle to a USB port closer to the keyboard and mouse.
- Remove any metal object between the Nano dongle and the keyboard and mouse that may interfere with reception.
- Try using the mouse on a different surface.
