#### Bluetooth Operation:

- Press the power button for 3 seconds to turn the speaker on. The LED indicator will flash to detect Bluetooth enabled devices near you. The indicator will go off if no Bluetooth devices detected within 5 minutes.
- Follow the instructions on the bluetooth device, and pair the speaker with the desired device.
- When you want to play audio from another Bluetooth device, disconnect the speaker and restart the Bluetooth speaker and re-pair.

### Phone Call Operations:

- Press the power button to answer an incoming call, press the power button to end the call.
- Press and hold the power button to reject the call.
- Double click the power button to redial the last phone number called.

# • 3.5 mm audio cable:

- Turn on the speaker.
- Pull the pull tab on the speaker to reveal the 3.5 mm aux jack and the micro-USB input port.
- Insert the provided 3.5mm audio cable into the aux jack, connecting to any audio device (phones, computers, etc.)
- Charging the speaker: approximately 3.5 hours to fully charge. Charge prior to initial use of the speaker.
- Turn on the speaker.
- Pull the pull tab on the speaker to reveal the 3.5 mm aux jack and the micro-USB input port.
- Insert the provided Micro-USB charging cable into the Micro-USB input port, the LED will light red until fully charged.
