- Insert two (2) AA batteries into the battery compartment.
 Insert the USB receiver into any available USB port on the PS3 the USB receiver's LED will flash.
 Power ON the "FightPad" the LED surrounding the Home button will flash while the "FightPad" is searching for a signal.
 Once a connection has been established, the LED surrounding the Home button will go out and the USB receiver's LED will turn solid.

The "FightPad" will enter sleep mode and all LEDs will go out after:

A) Ten (10) minutes of D-Pad or action button inactivity.
 B) One (1) minute of no RF connectivity.

Press the Home button.
 Slide the Power switch to OFF then back to ON.

Low Battery Indication:

If you encounter a low battery during gameplay, the LED on the right side of the "Start" button will flash at a rate of eight (8) times per second.

The "FightPad" is equipped with a 3-way switch labeled "LS," "DP" and "RS," which allows the D-Pad to emulate either the left or right analog stick of a standard controller. Set the switch to the desired location to make use of this feature.

Turbo Button Usage:

a solid Red light. If there is no light visible, make sure the USB receiver is plugged in all the way.

Q: The D-Pad doesn't function at all when I try inputting directions. Why is that?
A: Ensure the Control Function Switch is set to either the left analog stick "(LS)" or D-Pad "(DP)"
