



FIRST-TIME CONNECTION TO YOUR PLAYSTATION 4 SYSTEM

On your PlayStation 4 system, navigate to the following screens in order:

Settings>Devices>Bluetooth Devices

Power on your controller. The LED above the PS button should be flashing alternately red and blue (if it is not then press and hold the sync button on your controller for three (3) seconds until the LED does flash red and blue)

Your controller should appear onscreen after a few seconds – select it using your DualShock®4 Wireless Controller and then select Connect onscreen

Your controller should now be connected (the LED should be lit solid blue) and will function on your Playstation 4 system
