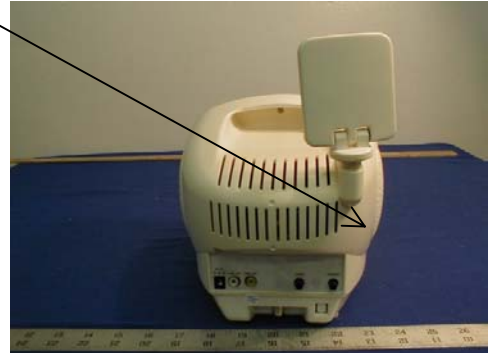
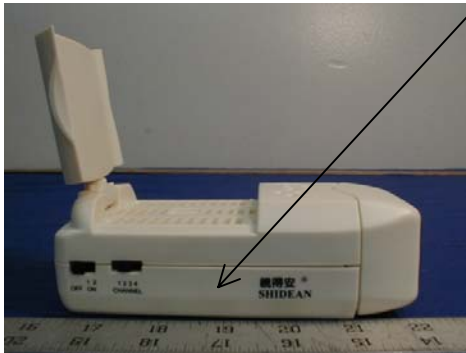

FCC Warning Statement

According to FCC 15.19 (a) (3) and (5), all device shall bear the following statement in a conspicuous location on the device:
