



## REMOTE OVERVIEW



Note: After the remote control turns on, the indicator light is always on. After connecting the signal of the remote control vehicle, the indicator light will turn on by pressing any button on the remote control

If you turn on the remote control and the indicator light is on, the indicator goes out after a long time without matching the remote, but the remote control is still in operation and needs to be turned off

## **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

- For indoor use only. Avoid water when operating
- Do not use people or animals as obstacles.

  Never operate your vehicle on the street or highway.
- Do not run car into furniture objects or hard surfaces as this will cause damage to both the objects and car.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires, gears and motor while car is switched to "ON".




