I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1) The 731 form is password protected and is unusable. Please upload revised Form 731 without password protection.
- 2) I also ask for you to check the channel numbering for both the 802.11 and the Bluetooth transmitter quoted throughout the Test Report and RF Exposure information. Are you sure that Channel 0 is the correct number?
- 3) Also, please note that 2.1033(b)(7) requires all photographs to be size A4 or 20.3cm x 25.4cm. Please limit your photos to one view per page only for all External and all Internal photographs.
- 4) The Manual does not make sense. Please see pp.22. This device contains both 802.11b and Bluetooth functions. Prohibitions against co-location are not appropriate. Please correct.
- 5) Can the Bluetooth and 802.11b operate simultaneously? If so, then the RF Exposure evaluation must evaluate the illumination that will occur with both transmitters operating.
