## 2.1033 (b)(4) Product Description.

You can activate the 911 guiding strobe by:

- 1. Dialing 911 from your phone
- 2. Programming another emergency number and dialing it
- 3. Pressing the *STROBE ON/OFF* button on the transmitter

The 911 Alert plugs into your telephone and senses when you dial 911 or any emergency number from any extension. Dialing 911 (or any other emergency number) triggers a radio frequency (RF) signal that begins flashing the Strobe. You can see the strobe from up to one mile away at night and up to 1/8 mile away during the day.

Each 911 model has its own user-specified signaling code. This allows your unit to operate totally independently of any other units in the neighborhood.

The transmitter sends a series of 8 bits either on or off in 750 milliseconds, the 8 bit code is sent three times in under three seconds once sent the transmitter ceases transmitting. The 8 bit code is recognized by the receiver and turns the strobe on. There is no other transmissions made unless someone dials 911 from there phone. The transmitter can not be used for voice or data transmissions. The transmitter complies with 15.231 (a) and 15.231(a) (3).
