HOW TO CONNECT TO A TV



- 1 Connect AV cable to RCA jack terminal in your TV as shown above
 If there are only two RCA jack terminal in your TV(mono TV), Connect
 the yellow jack(male) into the Yellow RCA jack terminal and connect
 the White jack(male) into the other RCA jack terminal of your TV.
- 2 Connect the other side of AV cable to RCA jack terminal of MAGICSING as shown above. Set the TV-channel to video (external input) mode.





HOW TO INPUT EXTERNAL VIDEO TO A TV



- 1 Connect External Video cable to "VIDEO OUT" jack terminal in optional video source (VCD, DVD, Video camera).
- 2 Connect the other side of External Video cable to "VIDEO IN" jack terminal in MAGICSING.
- 3 Press MODE+MODE+1 to use external video input as background and play optional video source.



1 MAIN STATION POWER ON/OFF & LED Descriptions

a. POWER on/off BUTTON

- Main power on/off switch on right side of main body POWER on/off indicate by LED

b. MIC 1 LED

- MIC 1 LED red light on : MIC1 operating



EG-18000 WIRELESS MIC KEY BUTTON DESCRIPTIONS



1 MIC Power Button



- Wireless MIC power on/off : please press button for 3 seconds (when main station switch is on)

2 ▼/▲ (UP / Down) Button



- Song list is appeared by press ▼/▲ button on Wireless MIC or remote controller
- Control the suggetion level of key, tempo, melody, mic volume, eco, & instrument
- Song selection by ▼/▲ button, once you press list of 10 songs are appeared on screen
- Select a song by press ▼/▲ button and play by[■/▶] button

3 VOL Button



- Volume control by [▼/▲] button for each MIC

4 RES (reservation) Button



- Please select a song and press [RES]
- It is used to pre-select(reserve) songs. Select a song number and press [RES] button. (your can reserve up to 20 songs but the screen displays only 5 songs during the playback) To delete a previously reserved song from the list, select the song then press [REC] to cancel it.
- Reserve a song during the MIC operating, reserved song may play after current operating song

6 MOD / MODE BUTTON



MODE button is used in conjunction with other buttons to access secondary functions

	Music Vol			
(MOD) + (1)	Allows you to set the volume of the music(0~15), using [▼/▲] button (Default is 10)			
	Melody Vol			
(MOD) + (2)	Press MODE+2 and adjust the melody volume level from 0 up to 15 by pressing $[\nabla/\Delta]$ button (Default is 10)			
	Tempo			
(MOD) + (3)	Allows you to set the tempo(-7~+8), using $[\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle]$ button (Default is 0)			
	Key			
(MOD) + (4)	Press MODE+4 and adjust the key by pressing $[\nabla / A]$ button (-7~+8), using $[\nabla / A]$ button (Default is 0)			
	Echo			
(MOD) + 5	Allows you to adjust the mic echo volume with 15 levels(0~15) by using $[\P/A]$ button (Default is 8)			
	Melody Instrument Change			
+6	Press [MODE] + [6], and change the instrument used in playing the melody by using $[\nabla / \triangle]$ button			
_	Section Repetition			
(MOD) + (7)	MODE+7 set the start MODE+7 set the end => section repeat => MODE+7 section repeat off			
	While a song is playing, unable the section-repeat mode			
	Realtime Score Check			
(MOD) + (8)	Shows the score of the singer while the song is still being sung			
	Challenge 100songs!			
(MOD) + (9)	This game has 100 steps and you have to figure out what song's title is.			
	In each step, a song is played back for 1 minute and you have to choose right title among 4 examples. If you choose right answer in each 5 step,			
	you can obtain one life. Press [MODE] to stop this game			
	Continuous Playback			
(MOD) + (D)	For continuous playback of songs in sequential order, select a starting song and press [MODE] + [0]			
(MOD) + (RES)	Search			
	Look for your favorite song			
	Press [MODE] + [RES] to enter the Search mode

	pause, press [►/■] again for continue to play

REC / RECORD

I. Record into Internal memory (Only 1song recordable)

Press [▶/■] to stop the recording

Press [REC] to start the playback of the previous recording

Press [►/■] to stop the playback

II. Record into recording pack

To recording


Insert the recording pack

Press [▶/■] to stop the recording


To replay the recorded songs
