



## **A LED STATUS INDICATOR**

- When the wireless microphone is in the process of pairing with the main station, the LED status indicator blinks.
- When the pairing is complete, the LED status indicator is turned on.

## **B POWER ON / OFF SWITCH**

- To turn on the wireless microphone, slide the switch upwards. The blue light indicates that it is turned on.
- ※ If you will not use the device, you may turn off the wireless microphones.
