Per our conversation, transmitted herewith, on behalf of **Growell Telecom Co., Ltd.**, is an amendment provided in response to the request for technical information dated August 23, 2002.

1. This model is electrically identical to the previous model: (FCC ID: PC6CF-2031) except a slight change in the PC board and has been upgraded to accommodate other host PC's. Please find attached the amended EMC portion of the report.
2. The reference to the Sierra Aircard was for the software driver for the device. This is because the manufacturer of the RF part is Sierra Wireless.
3. Photos of the battery pack are attached. Since the EUT contains a transmitter the battery pack is used to extend the talk/text time.
4. Growell has confirmed that the users manual has 2 pages per page shown. Please note that this manual is preliminary and contains all the pages that Growell has provided to PCTEST.
5. Yes, the SAR setup photo is applicable for device in a laptop. Please find attached a revised SAR set photo with the laptop.
6. Attached is the test data and photo for the PCS CDMA Type II CF Modem Card. The EUT was tested with the Panasonic CF-72 Notebook PC in the lap position.
7. Please note that a Class II Permissive change will be filed to the FCC within 30 days to remove the single host condition on the grant.
