Upon completion of review of the Microwave Oven application FCC ID: PVCMF124603A, there are several discrepancies that must be addressed before the applications can be granted by ATCB.

Please address each issue below.

- 1) We cannot honor the request for confidentiality for internal and external pictures. The FCC only recognizes the following documents to be listed as confidential. These include, Oats list, Bill of Material, Theory of Operation, Block Diagram or Schematics. We would need to address with the FCC the request for why the posting of the pictures in your public file would damage trade secrets if released. I very much doubt the FCC would consider external pictures confidential or even most of the internal pictures.
- 2) The report submitted was scanned in backwards and has pages out of order, the FCC may not accept this if for auditing purposes.
- 3) Please do not send zip files to the site, but upload standard "pdf" files.
- 4) Please verify the FCC ID on the product, it appears the FCC grantee code PVC is registered to another firm,
- 5) Please provide a valid FCC Registration Number "FRN". This number can be obtained off the FCC web site and is now required by each applicant (not the test lab). Only one FRN number is needed per applicant company.
