Subject: Attestation for RF Exposure Compliance

Gentlemen:

Please be advised that the Intel model 622ANXHMW, FCC ID: PD9622ANXHU, originally granted 10/01/2009 has requested approval of a Class 2 Permissive Change for the modular transmitter covered by this ID to document reduced output powers in 802.11b mode in the auxiliary transmit chain only. This change in power is implemented due to a change in the front end module (FEM) to a new supplier. The new FEM is electrically identical and pin for pin compatible to the original device.

All previous Class 2 permissive changes for this ID were to evaluate SAR compliance when the module was installed in specific host and antenna combinations under portable conditions. Any future authorization for use of this same module under portable will be subject to SAR evaluation and authorization.
