## MPE Prediction

Predication of MPE limit at a given distance.

Equation from page 18 of OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01

 $S=PG/4\pi R^2$ 

Where: S = power density (in appropriate units, e.g. mW/cm<sup>2</sup>)

P = power input to the antenna (in appropriate units, e.g., mW)

G = power gain of the antenna in the direction of interest relative to an isotropic radiator

R = distance to the center of radiation of the antenna (appropriate units, e.g., cm)

Max tune up power : -3.28 dBm (0.469 mW)

Prediction distance : 20 cm
Predication frequency : 2 425 MHz

Antenna gain(Max) : 3.25 dBi (2.113 numeric)

Power density at predication frequency at 20 cm : 0.000 197 57 mW/cm²

MPE Limit for : 1 mW/cm<sup>2</sup>

## **Test Result**

The power density level at 20 cm is 0.000 197 57 mW/cm<sup>2</sup> which is below the uncontrolled exposure limit of 1 mW/cm<sup>2</sup> at 2 425 MHz to 2 475 MHz.
